

Davorin Kereković was born on August 14, 1946, in Zagreb, died on August 11, 2020, during organizations 27th "GIS Odyssey 2020" conference.

He graduated from the Faculty of Philosophy and obtained a diploma in sociology and philosophy. He has been secretary of the Croatian IT Association GIS Forum since its establishment in 1994. As part of his activities at the GIS Forum, he implemented projects in the field of geoinformatics and the restoration of cultural, architectural and sculpture monuments. He organized international conferences and exhibitions on Geographic Information Systems.

He has been passionate about photography since his student years. He was the author and organizer of numerous exhibitions in Croatia and Poland. Among others, during the International Conference and Exhibition "GIS Polonia 2008" in Zakopane and Krakow, he presented his exhibitions: "European Cultural Heritage - Architecture & Sculpture" and "Krakow in Heart and on Photography". The exhibition "Kraków in Heart and on Photography" was also presented in 2007 in Zagreb during the celebration of the 89th anniversary of Poland regaining independence.

Cooperation with Michał Wojnar became an inspiration for the joint exhibition "Shells of the World – Drawings and Photographs", presented for the first time during the "GIS Polonia 2008" conference, and then, among others, in the Municipal Public Library in Jaworzno, entitled "Shells of the World Through the Eyes of a Drawer and Photographer".
